## Lay Net Permit Lay Net Marking Instructions

The Lay Net Permit (LNP) is a requirement per Hawai'i Administrative Rule §13-75-12.4. Before utilizing a lay net, it is required to have proper identification tags attached with the Lay Net Permit number. Please note, you will need to purchase and/or create your own tags and buoys.

Lay net marking and placement requirement instructions are as follows:

- 1. All lay nets you are using must be tagged with your Lay Net Permit number.
- 2. Identification tags must be legible and clearly labeled with the last five (5) digits of your DAR-issued lay net permit number.



- 3. Every net must have a total of four (4) identification tags. Each of the tags will need to be attached to the four corners of your net (see red arrows below).
- 4. In addition to the identification tags attached to the four corners of the net, surface buoys must be attached to each end of the float line for a total of two (2) buoys for each lay net (see blue arrows below). Surface buoys must:
  - a. Legibly and clearly display the lay net permit number of the person using the lay net.
  - b. Be marked with reflective tape.
  - c. Be visible above the surface of the water.
